PHASE 1 – REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION

 Applicants must register and upload their application documents to the Angewandte application platform (<u>https://application.uni-ak.ac.at</u>) between 15th and 29th January 2025, 1 pm (noon, CET).

PHASE 2 – INTERVIEW

- If you have passed phase 1, you will be invited to an online interview. Information to applicants about **invitation** to **online interviews** will be communicated via mail on **5th Febraury 2025**.
- 3. Interviews by examination committee with applicants will be conducted **between 24th and 28th February 2025**.
- 4. Information on admission will be communicated by 14th March 2025.

PHASE 1

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Upload all application documents in <u>one single PDF file</u> (not more than 50 MB); The requested documents are:

1. A written assignment which consists of a text (400–500 words) on the following issue:

"If you could remove one thing from the world, what would it be and why?"

The text may be accompanied and extended by any audiovisual material.

2. CV in Europass format or adequate form (https://europa.eu/europass/en)

3. Motivation letter, in which the applicant describes their expectations of the program and their interest in the transformative connections of art x science; (500–800 words)

INTERVIEW

In the interview, the examination committee discusses with the applicant their motivation to study, their main areas of interest regarding the program and their extent of creativity shown in working on the assignment.
