

## INFORMATION ON ENTRANCE EXAM

### for the academic year 2019/2020

Dear applicant,

the next possible start to study Fashion at the Fashion Department is **winter term 2019/20** (starts October 1, 2019). The **entrance exam** takes place **from February 25 to 28, 2019** and is divided into 2 parts:

#### **1) SUBMISSION OF PORTFOLIO**

A portfolio with samples of the applicant's work must be submitted to the **Fashion Department, Oskar Kokoschka Platz 2, 4th floor, 1010 Vienna on Monday, February 25 between 10 am and 4 pm**. You do not need to register for submission or bring any further documents; all documents required are available at the Fashion Department. Please note: You must hand in your portfolio in person – no third parties allowed!

The portfolio (not larger than A2) has to present your artistic ideas in the field of clothes and fashion by means of drawing, collage, photography, etc. Please find your own way to communicate your visions in the best way possible and make them understandable to us.

We offer the possibility of **consultancy talks** on your portfolio with our team:

**Wednesday, November 14, 2018** 10 am–5 pm

**Wednesday, January 23, 2019** 10 am–5 pm

No application required!

#### **2) ENTRANCE EXAM**

The best portfolios will be chosen by the Professor of the Fashion Department. Applicants accepted to enter the entrance exam will be announced **on February 26 at 2 pm** at the Fashion Department.

##### **-) Applicants not accepted to enter the entrance exam**

Please pick up your portfolio on February 26 between 2 pm and 4 pm at the Fashion Department.

##### **-) Applicants accepted to enter the entrance exam**

The exam will take place **on February 27** from 10 am to 7 pm **and February 28** from 3:30 to 10 pm at the Fashion Department. All materials needed will be announced on February 26 at 2 pm.
