TransArts – Transdisciplinary Art

Master Programme: Admission Information for 2020/21

Admittance to the master studies of TransArts requires evidence of completed, subject-relevant studies to the extent of at least 180 ETCS, or completed artistic master studies extending to at least 120 ECTS, at an art university or domestic/foreign tertiary educational institution of equal standing. Admittance further requires evidence of artistic suitability as part of the entrance examination.

The entrance examination consists of two parts and is used to assess exceptional visual talent and the ability to combine this talent with other creative or cognitive skills. The objective of the master programme is to further enhance the ability to successfully develop and employ investigative-innovative artistic processes and to establish an independent artistic position.

First part: Assessment of the submitted portfolio and supporting documents

Second part: Practical work on a posed topic, personal interview

Upon **registration**, the following must be submitted:

- documentation of the graduation project from prior studies,
- a portfolio of representative artistic sample work,
- a curriculum vitae, and
- a letter of motivation in which personal expectations for the programme are explained.

Portfolio

- free choice of format (maximum portfolio size A1)
- the portfolio should document the current state of your artistic approach in the medium of your choice.

 There are no boundaries to the scope or topics of the work, whereby the aspect of topicality in connection with contemporary art and its discourse is an important criteria
- content:
- e.g. project ideas, visualised concepts, drawings, photography, videos, documentation of three-dimensional work, documentation of projects in performing arts, architecture, visual art, etc.
- a comprehensive concept for a semester project with sketches, designs, models, or other visualisations as well as a supporting text

Entrance Examination Dates for the 2020/21 Academic Year

February 24 and 25, 2020, 9:00 – 12:00: Registration and submission of portfolio and supporting documents February 25, 2020, 6:00 pm: Announcement of candidates admitted to the second part of the examination February 26 to 28, 2020: Second part of the entrance examination March 2, 2020: Announcement of the results

All dates take place in the rooms of the TransArts class, Vordere Zollamtsstraße 7, 1030 Vienna, 2nd floor.

Admission to Studies in the Subsequent Winter Semester

Upon successful completion of the entrance examination, admission to studies ensues in the subsequent winter semester (approx. mid-September 2020).
