The four-year diploma program encourages students to develop their creative style and artistic vision while gaining essential research, technical and communication skills. In one-to-one and group tutorials and through conceptual guidance with the internationally acclaimed fashion designers at the helm of the Department, students generate ideas, develop concepts and create and present individual, innovative and visionary womenswear, menswear or non-binary fashion collections. The main course, the so-called central artistic subject, focuses on developing an original and dynamic design vision. Accelerating creative, practical and intellectual development through interdisciplinary work processes and experimentation.

Graduates either found their own fashion labels or launch careers at existing national and international labels and/or fashion houses. Thanks to the continued high quality of the training it offers and its many successful graduates, the Fashion Department is one of the most important fashion education institutions worldwide.

Entrance Exam



ENTRANCE EXAM

To study at the Fashion Department, interested applicants need to pass an ENTRANCE EXAM. The next possible entrance exam will take place in January/February/March 2026 and will be held in 2 PHASES:

PHASE 1 consists of online submission including uploading a portfolio. All applicants who successfully complete PHASE 1 are qualified to participate in PHASE 2. PHASE 2 takes place in Vienna at the Fashion Department, participation in person during this period is required.

A successfully passed entrance exam is valid for three semesters. The earliest date to start your studies is winter term 2026/27, starting October 2026.

The entrance exam will be held in English, knowledge of the German language is not a precondition.

FORMAT OF THE PORTFOLIO

- one document, format exclusively A4 landscape
- scanned with a maximum of 150 dpi per page
- the size of the PDF document may not exceed 50 MB
- save the PDF document under your last name, first name, for example Green-Craig.pdf

CONTENT OF THE PORTFOLIO

1. COVER SHEET (1 page)

Including your first name, last name, phone number and a valid email address.

2. PHOTO SERIES (max. 5 pages) SUBMIT 5 PHOTOGRAPHS OF YOUR CHOICE WHICH DEMONSTRATE YOUR CREATIVE VISION AND HOW YOU SEE THE WORLD

- These must be personal photographs (old or new, taken by yourself or somebody you know personally). Images must not be from secondary source materials.
- There are no rules for the subject matter, style or format of the photographs: images can be of yourself, your environment, other people, objects, places, landscapes, abstract or mood, things that you have made or noticed etc.
- Each image should feature a single word or short text description, in the style of your choosing (max. 10 words each image).
- 3. FASHION COLLECTION (max. 14 pages) DESIGN A WOMENSWEAR, MENSWEAR OR NON-BINARY CAPSULE COLLECTION
- Visual and conceptual research
- Drawings (or collages) a minimum 5 full looks
- Documentation of 2D-development ideas, print or fabric developments

4. ILLUSTRATION (1 page) CREATE 1 SINGLE ILLUSTRATION / 2D-ARTWORK OF

- The medium used for the illustration is completely your choice (pencil, pen, painting, digital render, pastels, ink, charcoal, photo collage, collage, rubbing, imprint etc.).
- The subject matter and style of the illustration is completely of your choice.
- 5. PREVIOUS WORK (max. 4 pages)

If you have previous work within any creative field and/or from any artistic training, include images.

All applicants will receive an email notification not later than February 06 whether they have successfully completed PHASE 1. All applicants who successfully complete PHASE 1 are qualified to participate in PHASE 2.

CREATIVE TASKS AND INTERVIEWS

PHASE 2 takes place in Vienna at the Fashion Department. Participation in person during this period is required, online participation is not permitted. At the beginning of PHASE 2, Professor Craig Green will announce creative tasks applicants will work on. Every applicant will have an interview with Professor Craig Green and team members of the Fashion Department. Further details will be sent with the invitation to PHASE 2.

DECISION

All participating applicants of PHASE 2 receive an email notification not later than March 13 whether they have successfully completed PHASE 2.

Frequently Asked Questions

A successfully passed entrance exam is valid for three semesters. The earliest date to start your studies is winter term 2026/27, starting October 2026.

- 1. After receiving an email notification from the Fashion Department in March that you successfully passed the entrance exam, please wait until summer 2026 as the Office of Student Affairs will contact you then with further information.
- 2. In case you start to study in winter term 2026/27, the Fashion Department will contact you not later than in September 2026 to announce a first meeting at the beginning of October.
