#### **Information about the webinars:**

Our interactive online webinars are conducted via zoom and are designed for beginners as well as advanced users.

#### **Requirements**

- Computer or mobile terminal device (e.g. mobile phone) with internet access
- Headset, or head phones and loudspeaker
- VPN access on your device is a prerequisite for the database research webinars
- Registration up to 2 days prior to the date of the webinar

#### **Information about classroom trainings:**

Our training sessions held at the library are open to all library users. No registration is required; simply come to the library at the designated time.

## **What we offer**

#### **Library Tour (on site)**

The tour includes a walk through the library premises, a presentation of our holdings (books, magazines, audio-visual media, special collections such as artists' books), information regarding the usage modalities and services, as well as a short introduction to the search portal supA with a subsequent book search.

Meeting point: Library entrance

Duration: approx. 30 min.

#### **Basics for Beginners and as a Refresher (on site)**

After an introduction to the Library, its holdings, and the current borrowing modalities, the webinar focusses on research using the online catalogue supA, in particular on the research of E-Books and E-Journals. In addition, there will be tips on how to research with success and participants can ask questions in connection with this topic. The objective is to demonstrate how efficient the use of this form of available information and media can be.

Duration: approx. 50 min.

#### **Database research: what's new? (Webinar)**

We have updated the introduction to database search in supA and explain in this short format the new search options for databases and how to access them. Opportunity to practice will be given.

Duration: approx. 30 min.

### **Database research for teaching staff** (Webinar, only in German)

This webinar addresses teachers and researchers at Angewandte and conveys an overview of the Library's large offer of databases. Furthermore, the webinar will demonstrate the use of a choice of relevant databases for research purposes and present specific research tools and features offered by those databases. These will include: the reference databases of ProQuest (e.g. Periodicals Index Online, ProQuest Primary Sources), the full-text databases of Bloomsbury, the press database PressReader and the streaming databases Kanopy and Dis.  
Duration: approx. 60 min.

### **Research in Individual Databases** (on site)

We present an overview of licensed databases available in the Library so that you know about the databases relevant to your study subject. After the overview of different types of database, we go through example researches in some individual databases. Specific research tools and features of the different types of database are looked at more closely. There will be an introduction to the reference databases of ProQuest (e.g. Periodicals Index Online, ProQuest Primary Sources), the full-text databases of Bloomsbury, the press database PressReader and the streaming database Kanopy.  
Duration: approx. 60 min.

### **Scientific Research** (Webinar)

We present further options to search for scientific documents on the internet. First and foremost is the search for electronically available full texts. Besides the research in library networks and DBIS, the database information system, we introduce you to specialist portals for scientific research. In addition, we provide information about various scientific search engines that give you access to freely available full-text.  
Duration: approx. 50 min.
